

Andrew LLOYD

Andrew LLOYD also sailed aboard the “Snow Owen” in 1770 as a settler bound for New England. In 1784, Andrew, his wife, Catherine LAWLESS and their daughter, Catherine are listed on a return of “Men, Women and Children of the late Fencible American Regiment”.

In 1798, he and his father in law, John LAWLESS negotiated to keep Campobello and Deer Islands British (as part of Canada).

Andrew LLOYD and Catherine LAWLESS are the grandparents of William Lloyd GARRISON, “the great abolitionist”.
