Jonathan Stover was a mariner and is recorded as one of the original settlers of Penobscot, Maine. In 1784, people “not friendly to the United States” were evicted from Maine and his land was given to “the widow Rhodes”.

In 1784, he petitioned with others and became one of the “Digdeguash Grantees” in St Patrick’s Parish, Charlotte County, New Brunswick”.

His daughter Mary, married Stephen Fountain, the grandson of Loyalist Stephen Fountain.
